South Dublin Deanery

There are 11 parishes in our Deanery: Templeogue, **Terenure**, Knocklyon, **Ballyroan**, Rathfarnham, **Churchtown**, Green Hills, **Kimmage**, Willington, **Ballyboden** and Firhouse. And there are 16 Deaneries in our Diocese

We gather a minimum of 4 times a year to Co-ordinate Pastoral activity and to keep the Archbishop informed. The Bishop meets with the 16 Vicars Foraine (the priest who is appointed to Chair the meetings). The VF (Me) has a Deanery Steering Committee to assist. This committee has Priests, Deacons and Reps of Parish Pastoral Councils.

What happens at a Deanery meeting has changed a lot over the last few years, and the Archbishop has a new Framework Document to come into force next September. Here's a quote from the Document:

The Deanery fosters pastoral care through common pastoral activity among parishes sharing resources to support such common pastoral activity.

The Deanery meeting took place in Templeogue church last Tue. The Big item at the meeting on Tue was the **Building Hope** process and looking at feedback from the **Synod meetings**. It's important to let people know what was sent in on behalf of each Parish who held Synodal meetings.

When Archbishop Farrell started as our New Bishop he began the **TaskForce**, looking for information/feedback on current issues in the

Diocese. We began the Task-force, then the **Synod (which is World-wide)**, put the **Task-force (which is Dublin Diocese only)**, on the back boiler for a while.

We're back on track with the Taskforce. The response to the Taskforce is the '**Building Hope**' process. Next step is to set-up a Building Hope Leadership group who will organize meetings, like the Synod meetings.

If you get a chance, look at the Diocesan Website and look at the Building Hope tab, you'll be amazed at the amount of resources etc. available to help.
